The course goals are to provide the class participants with current information dealing with the proper investigation and detection of physical child abuse and homicide of children. Participants will study the various injuries that are often inflicted on children to include: bruises, burns, bone injuries, and failure to thrive. Additionally, participants will study the various syndromes that are generally associated with child physical abuse and homicide. The participants will gain an understanding of the dynamics of the offender (s) and what the common explanations are most often given for the assaults.
